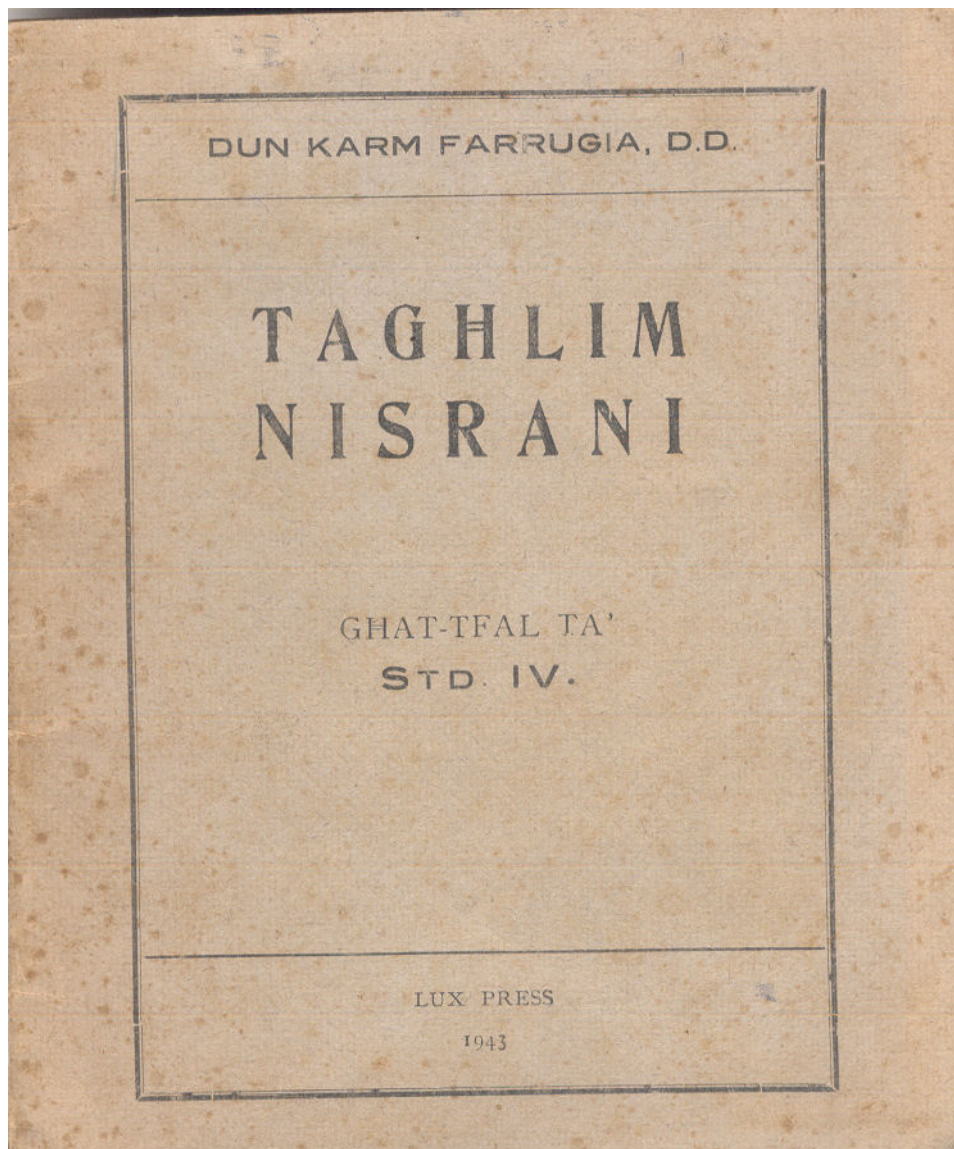
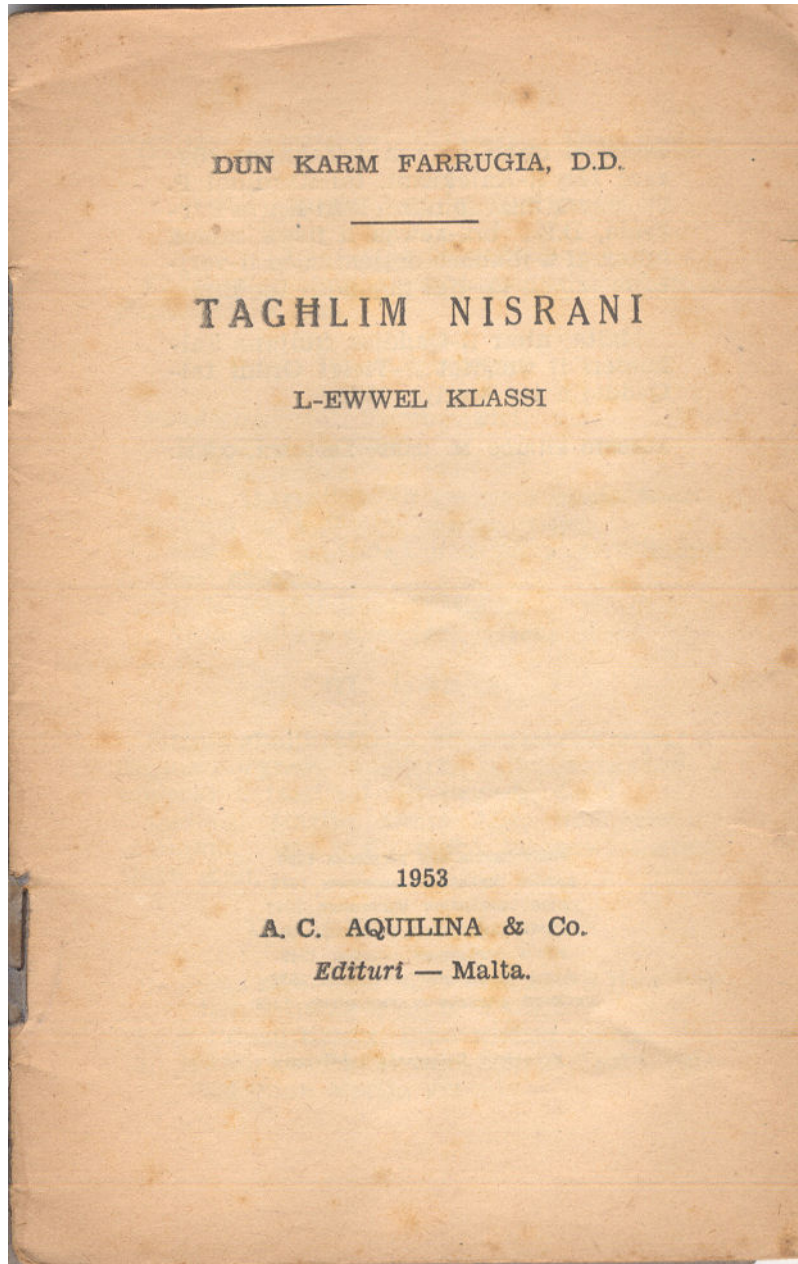

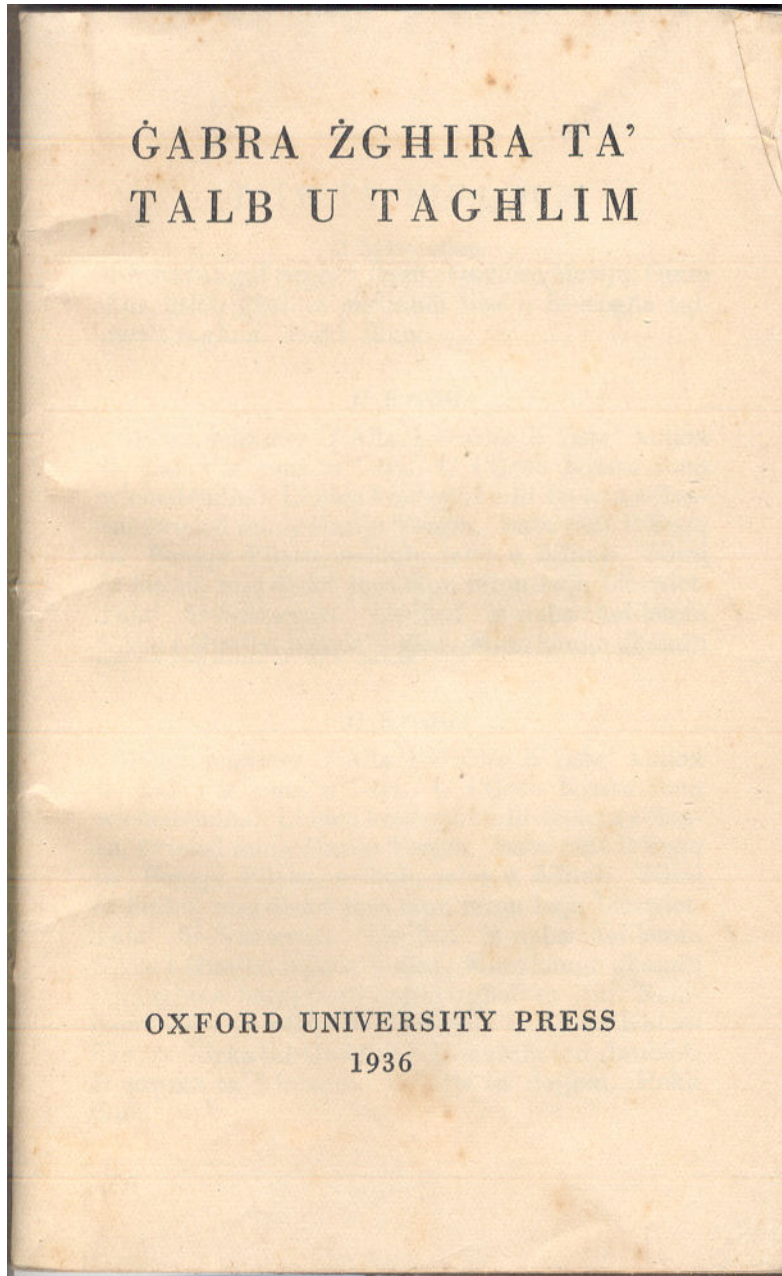
The front page of *Tagħlim Nisrani*, a booklet extracted from the Gasparri Catechism and was studied in all Maltese infant classes.

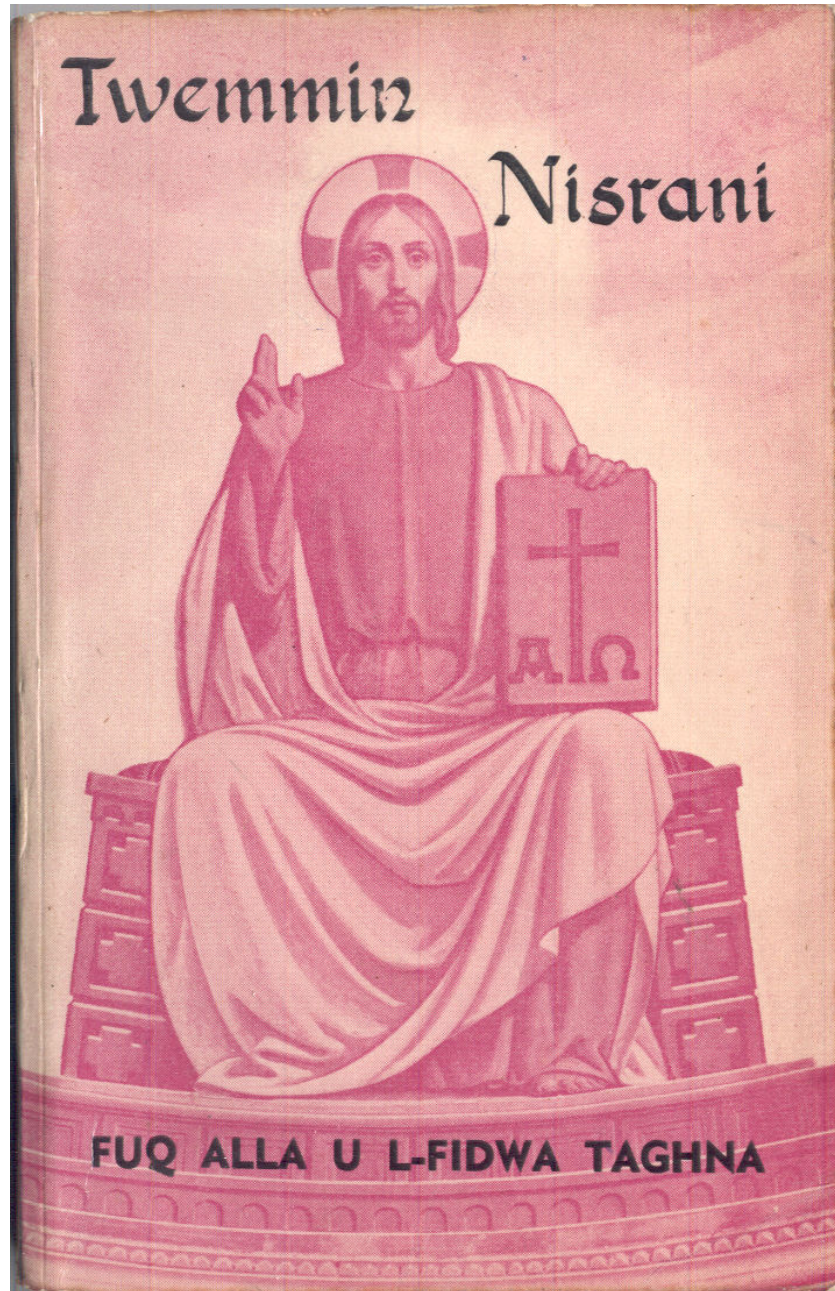
A 1953 edition of *Tagħlim Nisrani* .

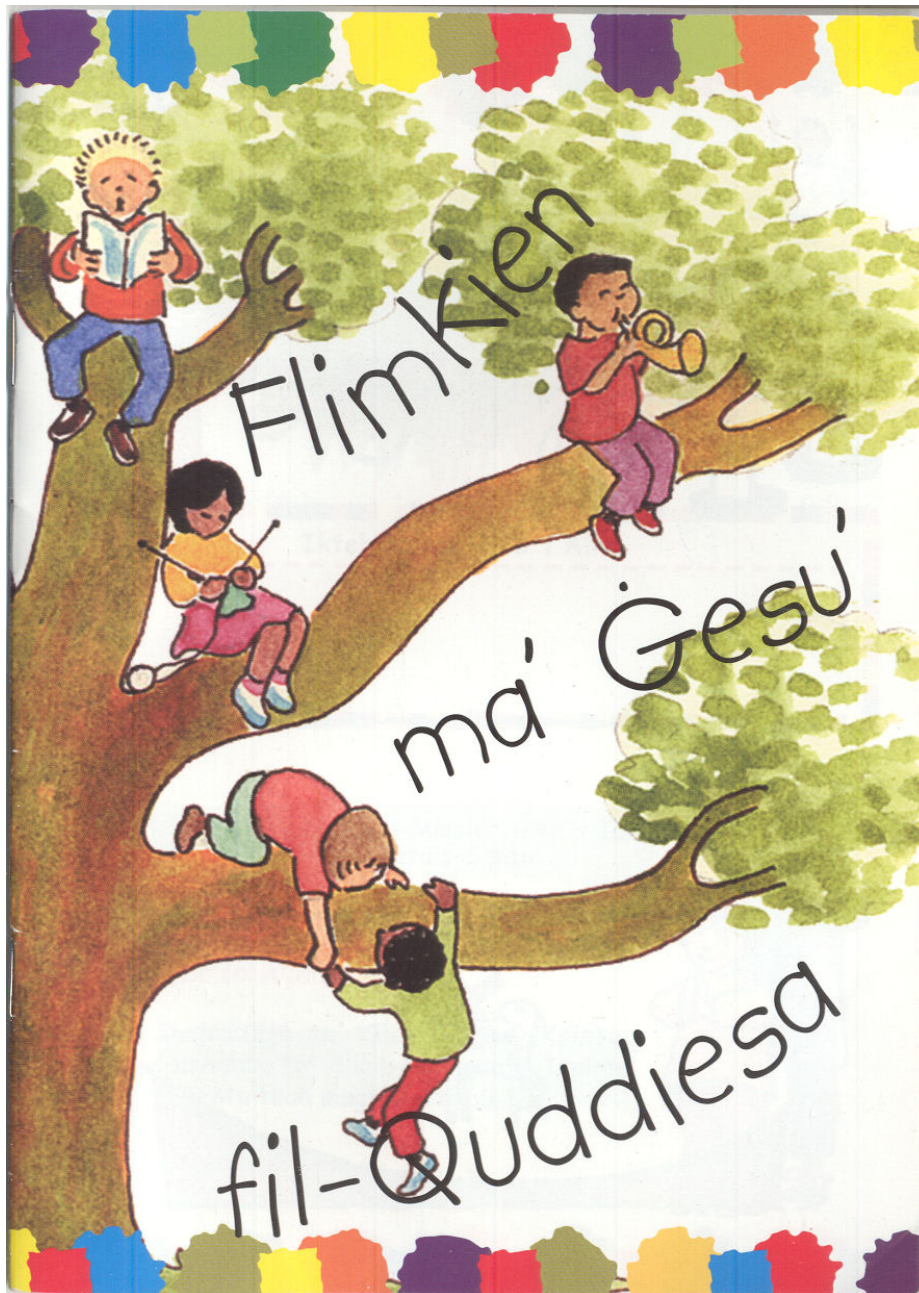

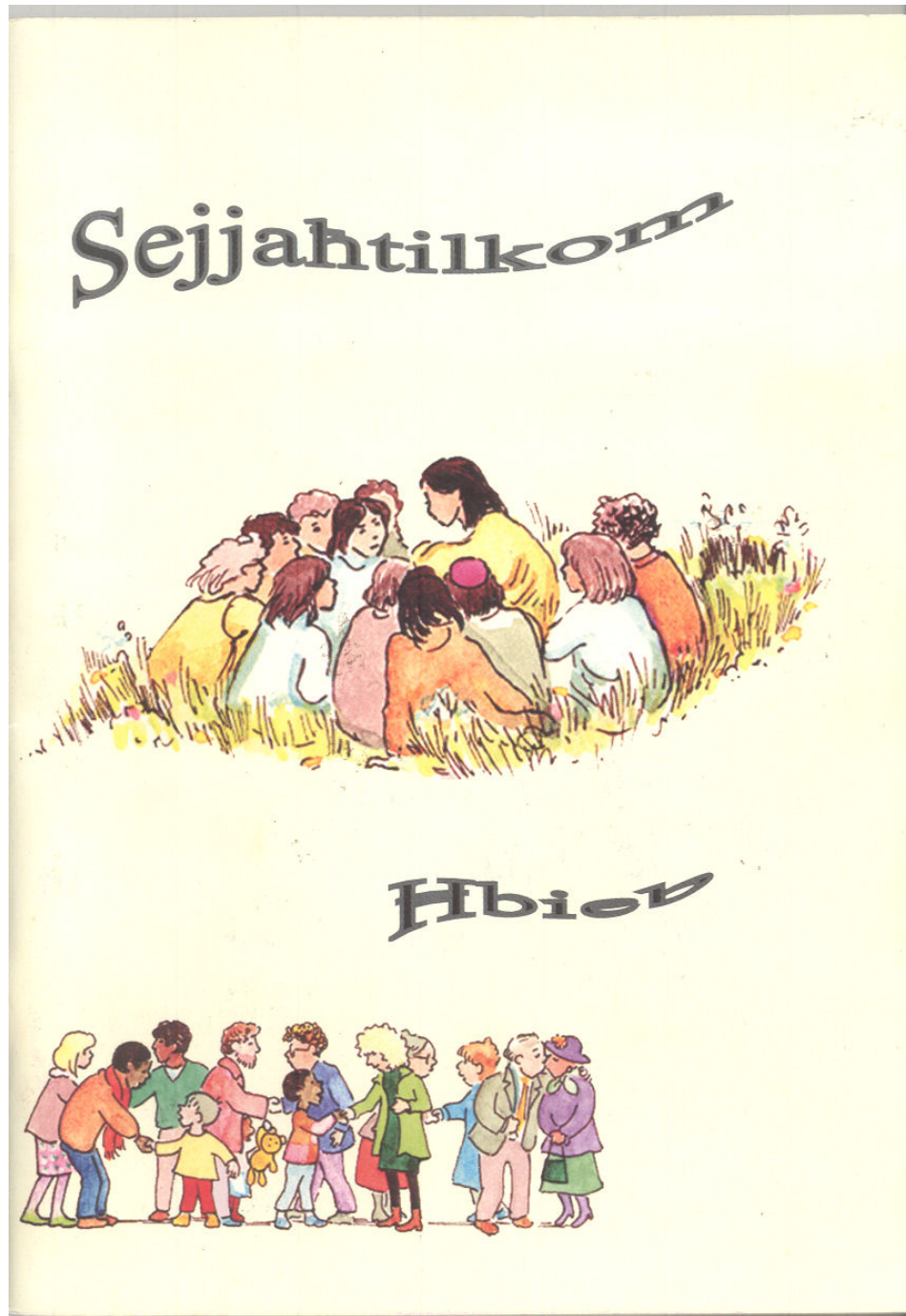
